- 3. How many of the illegal handguns seized by Customs contained no serial number or identification information?
- 4. What proportion of illegal imports did this cohort represent?
- 5. How many times has Customs acted on the advice of the NSW Police Force in regards to the illegal importation of guns into Australia since the NSW Police uncovered the gun smuggling ring operating out of Sylvania Waters in March last year?
