Senator Cash (Written) asked:

The Capability Review warns that "over-reliance on the current demanddriven quarantined funding is a key risk for the department at a time of fiscal constraint". What would be the impact on the Department if that demanddriven funding is withdrawn in the forward years, as indicated in the drop in out year forecasts in PAES?

Answer:

The department has reviewed the funding approach for Asylum-seeker management with Department of Finance and Deregulation to ensure an appropriate funding model is in place. For 2013–14 and the forward estimates, the department is funded through a demand driven model, and the assumptions which underpin this funding arrangement are complex and are updated regularly through normal budgetary process.
