(AE13/0442) PROGRAM – 4.3: Offshore Asylum Seeker Management

Senator Cash (Written) asked:

a) What is the cost of goods supplied to detainees through the Christmas Island Detention Centre store per month in 2011/12 and 2012/13 to date? b) How do detainees accumulate points for use in the Christmas Island store? Has this changed since 1 July 2011? What is the current maximum point balance for any detainee in the Christmas Island IDC? c) What goods are available to detainees through the store and what is the price in points for each of these items? d) How many points were exchanged by detainees for food and other goods at the Christmas Island detention centre store, as part of the individual allowance program, per month in 11/12 and 12/13 to date?

Answer:

a) The cost of goods supplied to people in detention through the Christmas Island Detention Centre store per month in financial years 2011-12 and 2012-13 is as follows:

- (b) Points are allocated as follows:
 - Adults are allocated 25 mandatory points per week, while an additional 25 may be accrued through participation in Programs and Activities. (50 points in total per week)
 - Minors aged between 12 and 17 (inclusive) are allocated 25 mandatory points per week, while an additional 15 may be accrued through participation in Programs and Activities. (40 points in total per week)
 - Minors under the age of 12 are allocated 20 mandatory points per week only (20 points in total per week). Minors under the age of 12 are not able to accrue points through Programs and Activities. However, they should be encouraged by parents, guardians or carers to participate in appropriate Programs and Activities.

This system has not changed since 1 July 2011. The maximum points balance that can be accrued by any person in detention is the maximum that can be obtained in a week (see above). Each week, balances are reset to zero.
