Senator Carr (Written) asked:

How many detainees will be/have been transferred from Pontville Immigration detention centre?

Which detention centred will they/were they transferred to?

How many have been/are going to be released into the community?

How many have been/are going to be voluntarily returned?

How many have been/are going to be involuntarily returned?

Answer:

During the period 7 September 2013 to 25 February 2014, five detainees were transferred from Pontville Alternative Place of Detention (APOD) into the community.

The department does not record information on removals from specific detention centres in a consolidated manner.
