Senator Carr (Written) asked:

How many detainees will be/have been transferred from the Port Augusta Immigration Residential Housing Centre?
Which detention centred will they/were they transferred to?
How many have been/are going to be released into the community?
How many have been/are going to be voluntarily returned?
How many have been/are going to be involuntarily returned?

Answer:

During the period 7 September 2013 to 25 February 2014, 11 detainees were transferred from Port Augusta Immigration Residential Housing (IRH). All of these detainees were transferred to Inverbrackie Alternative Place of Detention (APOD).

The department does not record information on removals from specific detention centres in a consolidated manner.
