Senator Carr (Written) asked:

The Department's figures show a total of nearly 260,000 WHV visas were granted in FY 2012-13 (258,248); and nearly 180,000 Working Holiday visa holders (subclasses 417 and 462) were present in Australia on 31 December 2013. The Department says Australia has reciprocal arrangements with WHV agreement countries.

Answer:

Australia currently has 28 reciprocal arrangements in effect with Working Holiday Maker arrangement partner countries.

The department confirms that in 2012-13, a total of 258 248 Working Holiday Maker visas were granted and that on 31 December 2013, 178 982 Working Holiday Maker visa holders were in Australia, as detailed in the following table:
