Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 25 May 2006:

a) Is there a difference in the customs duty payable on bunker or shipping fields between ships engaged on coastal voyages and those engaged on international voyages?

b) What are the differential rates?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

a) Ships on an international voyage do not pay customs duty on bunkers.

b) The duty rate on bunkers is either \$0.40143 per litre or \$0.38143 per litre depending on the type of fuel purchased.
