Baxter closing 2008

- 1. Provide a copy of the review of longer-term detention facility planning.
- 2. A 'detention facilities strategy' is mentioned in a Minister's press release. Can you please provide a copy of the strategy?
- 3. Did the review of detention centres include off-shore detention centres? If so, what were the recommendations regarding off-shore detention centres?
- 4. Will Baxter be used by the military when it becomes a contingency facility?
- 5. What is the projected cost of keeping Baxter as a contingency facility?

Answer:

The viability of keeping Baxter Immigration Detention Facility (IDF) open/operational will be reviewed in 2007-08.

1. The review of detention facility planning is contained in the Onshore Detention Strategy paper at Attachment A.

- 2. Yes, the Onshore Detention Strategy paper is provided at Attachment A.
- 3. As detailed at Attachment A, the Onshore Detention Strategy covers only onshore detention facilities.
- 4. Baxter IDC will not be available for use by any other departments or organisations in the foreseeable future.
- 5. As of June 2006, the projected cost of keeping Baxter IDF as a contingency facility is \$1.5 million per annum.
