Finalisations

- 3,071 cases have been finalised since 1 July 2005.
- 56.7% of these cases were finalised within 90 days of receiving the Department's file.
- 86.6% of detention cases and 54.8% of community cases were finalised within 90 days of receiving the Department's file.
- Average time taken to finalise cases since 1 July 2005 has been 99 days.
- Average time taken to finalise cases in March was 94 days compared to 82 days in April. The average time in May to date has been 87 days.
