Amount of GST Collected on Firearms

Total GST paid (including GST deferred) on firearms imported into Australia over this period was \$2,657,343.05.

Types of Firearms Imported

Figures available for the last financial year 1 July 2005 to 30 June 2006.

The breakdown of imported firearms into either single shot or multiple shot is not readily available. Customs does not collect the information in this format as there is no operational or regulatory requirement to do so.
