The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The implementation of the same-sex measures across all relevant agencies will result in the following approximate net expenditure over five years (\$ million):

| 2007-08 | 2008-09 | 2009-10 | 2010-11 | 2011-12 |

The majority of expenditure in 2008-09 will be to implement changes to Centrelink's payment systems (including training, communication, forms and letters).

Other expenditure will be used to put procedures and directives in place, for additional client contact and to update relevant publications.
