Senator Barnett asked the following question at the hearing on 26 May 2008:

Please give a breakdown over the past 12 months indicating the number of hours worked on drug interdiction matters.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

From 31 May 2007 to 31 May 2008, a total of 640,030 hours were attributed to drug interdiction matters by AFP members. The three drug incident types and total amount of hours include:

Drugs – Imported: 634 417

Drugs – Exported: 144

Drugs – Trafficked: 5 469
