## **Question No. 34**

## Senator Siewert asked the following question at the hearing on 27 May 2008:

Provide a breakdown of the 330 intelligence reports into what relates to drug issues versus child abuse issues.

## The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

Many of the intelligence reports identify both child abuse and substance abuse in a single report as these issues often co-exist.

Child abuse is mentioned in 169<sup>#</sup> of the 344\* intelligence reports. This represents almost 50 per cent of all reports. Drug related issues are mentioned in 73 of the 344 reports. This represents 21 per cent.
