Senators Barnett and Brandis asked the following question at the hearing on 27 May 2008:

Secure Schools Program:

- (a) What are the three jurisdictions that have provided informal responses to the Minister for Home Affairs' letter of 11 March 2008?
- (b) What response have these three jurisdictions provided?
- (c) How many schools have each of the jurisdictions nominated?
- (d) What criterion has to met by the relevant schools?
- (e) Please provide a copy of the guidelines for the program?

The answer to the honourable senators' question is as follows:

- (a) As at 19 June 2008, the ACT, WA, NT, NSW, VIC, QLD and SA governments have responded to the Minister for Home Affairs' letter.
- (b) The ACT, WA, NSW, VIC, QLD and SA governments have nominated schools, while the NT government provided a nil response.
