Senator Ellison (L&CA 17) asked:

Does the funding allocated in this year's budget provide an increase in payments for translators and interpreters for the jobs that they do?

Answer.

This funding does not provide for an increase in payments for interpreters.

TIS National, however, has recently reviewed its remuneration for contracted interpreters over the past two years and as a result will implement an annual adjustment in contractor payments based on the CPI rate in the preceding calendar year. Contractors will be receiving a 3 per cent increase in payments from 1 July 2008.
