Senator Barnett asked the following question at the hearing on 25 May 2009:

- 1. The firm have an excellent knowledge of the Melbourne Commonwealth Law Court (CLC).
- 2. They have previously conducted works within Melbourne CLC for other jurisdictions and legal entities.
- 3. They have a sound knowledge of the stakeholders and a good working rapport with them.
- 4. They were available to undertake this consultancy role immediately.
- 5. They were able to meet the timeframes identified by the Court for the delivery of the services.
