## Senator Barnett asked the following question after the hearing on 27 May 2009:

Regarding the proposed National Personal Property Securities Campaign, what it its current status and what will be the status of this campaign if the legislation is deferred?

## The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The formal communications campaign for the Australian Government's personal property securities reform has not begun. Initial developmental market research has been commissioned to inform engagement with stakeholders on PPS reform and assist planning for the campaign. The campaign is planned to start six months prior to the new national PPS system commencing operation. If the commencement date for the new system is deferred, the communications campaign will be deferred accordingly.
