# (23) Program 2.1: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Hanson-Young (L&CA 109) asked:

- (1) Provide the number of asylum seeker protracted cases being assessed in Indonesia.
- (2) How many people does the UNHCR refer to Australia for resettlement out of Indonesia?

#### Answer.

- (1) There are some 185 UNHCR-registered asylum seekers in a protracted situation in Indonesia.
- (2) Of these, UNHCR has referred some 120 to Australia for resettlement. Around a fifth had been granted visas as at the end of May 2009. The others were awaiting the results of health and character checks.
