## Senator Barnett asked:

- (1) Has the portfolio/agency paid its accounts to contractors/consultants etc in accordance with Government policy in terms of time for payment (ie. within 30 days)? - (3) Where interest is being paid, what rate of interest is being paid and how is this rate determined?
