Answer:

The Department produces a standard poster, *It's OK to Complain*, that is displayed at Christmas Island and all immigration detention facilities around Australia. The poster is available in a number of different languages.

The Department also displays other posters that are produced by the Commonwealth Ombudsman and the Australian Human Rights Commission which also outline how to make a complaint.
