**Question No. 1**

**Senator Barnett asked the following question at the hearing on 25 May 2011:**

**Senator BARNETT:** ... So, with respect, you are paying these three new panel members—I presume they are going to be paid for their part time work.

**Ms Broderick:** That is right. They will be paid according to the Remuneration Tribunal, which has a daily rate. We do not have a daily rate here but I think it is around \$500 a day, or of that order. We can take that on notice.

**Senator BARNETT:** Sure, just double check that on notice and I would be happy.

**The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:**

Panel members on the *Review of the Treatment of Women in the Australian Defence Force Academy and Australian Defence Force* are paid a daily rate of \$570. This figure is based on rates as set by the Remuneration Tribunal for personnel exercising commensurate functions.
