Senator Barnett asked the following question at the hearing on 25 May 2011:

Senator BARNETT: ... So, with respect, you are paying these three new panel members—I presume they are going to be paid for their part time work.

Ms Broderick: That is right. They will be paid according to the Remuneration Tribunal, which has a daily rate. We do not have a daily rate here but I think it is around \$500 a day, or of that order. We can take that on notice.

Senator BARNETT: Sure, just double check that on notice and I would be happy.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

Panel members on the *Review of the Treatment of Women in the Australian Defence Force*Academy and Australian Defence Force are paid a daily rate of \$570. This figure is based on rates as set by the Remuneration Tribunal for personnel exercising commensurate functions.
