Senator Cash asked:

On 27 January 2011 the government announced a five-day turnaround for applications for 457 visas in response to demand for labour on infrastructure projects. In what skill areas have these been issued?

Answer:

There is no arrangement for a five-day turnaround for visa applications in relation to infrastructure projects.

On 27 January 2011, the Prime Minister announced that there would be priority processing of decision-ready subclass 457 visa applications for businesses assisting with flood reconstruction in Queensland.

Visas granted under the arrangement have primarily been for tradespersons, technicians and engineers.
