Senator Cash asked:

How many grants were made for offshore applications for protection visas under our refugee and humanitarian program in 2010/11 and by post, by post and nationality group?

Answer.

None. Protection visas are granted to people who seek protection and are determined to be a refugee after arrival in Australia. Applicants outside Australia may apply for a visa under either the Refugee or Special Humanitarian categories.
