Senator Cash asked:

How many onshore protection visa applications, by nationality, were lodged by people, who were not Irregular Maritime Arrivals, and arrived without visas or identity documentation, i.e. were unlawful?

Answer.

In 2010–11, 27 people arrived at an Australian airport without documentation and raised a protection claim.

The claimed nationalities on arrival were:
