Senator Cash asked:

In relation to the Broadmeadows facility, has any damage been caused to the facility as a consequence of detainee actions; if so, what was the cost of repairs for the damage?

Answer:

Yes – damage has been caused at the Melbourne Immigration Transit Accommodation (also referred to as Broadmeadows) as a result of clients' actions. The cost of repairs for the damage was approximately \$40 000.
