Has the South Australian police entered the Inverbrackie facility in response to a disturbance? How many times?

*Answer:*

The South Australian Police have entered the Inverbrackie facility on five occasions:

- On three occasions they attended at Serco's request to investigate alleged assaults between clients;
- On one occasion they were requested by Serco to investigate an incident of client self-harm; and
- On the other occasion they attended in response to a request from a member of the public regarding a possible fire at the facility.
