Provide a breakdown by month (year to date) of cases that are currently being case managed that have sought judicial review and have failed.

Answer:

As at 22 May 2012, DIAC records indicated that a total of 85 irregular maritime arrivals (IMAs) currently being case managed have been unsuccessful in their applications for judicial review (year to date). Some of these people may seek to appeal the court decisions in higher courts. Below is a breakdown by month.
