Senator Cash asked:

What has been the cost of operating the detention facilities at Pontville, in 2011-12? Please provide a breakdown of those costs including capital and repair costs.

Answer.

It is anticipated that the Pontville direct operational costs for the 2011-12 financial year will be as follows:

These figures will be confirmed once the Department's 2011-12 financial statements have been completed and signed off by the Australian National Audit Office.

In addition for the financial year to 30 June 2012 there has been \$12,175,273 in capital expenditure. Works undertaken included:

- the purchase of furniture, furnishings and equipment;
- upgrade of fencing, security, IT and data; and
- installation of demountable buildings.

Ongoing maintenance and repair costs are included in the IT, Communications, motor vehicle and property expenses category in the table above.
