(BE12/0243) Program 2.1: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Cash asked:

What is the average time taken to process the offshore humanitarian and refugee visas from application to grant at each of the posts?

Answer:

During 2011-12 to date, the average time taken to process offshore humanitarian visas from application to grant is 41.5 weeks. Table 1 provides the average time taken to process applications for all posts.
