Senator Cash (L&CA 79) asked:

How many Subclass 866 Protection visas have been cancelled since November 2011 and why?

Answer.

Between 01 November 2011 and 30 April 2012, four Protection (Class XA) (subclass 866) visas were cancelled.

System records indicate that:

- two visas were cancelled under section 501(1)(6), of the *Migration Act 1958* which relates to the character test;
- one cancellation was made under section 103, of the *Migration Act 1958* which relates to the provision of fraudulent or bogus documents;
- one cancellation was made under section 116(1)(a), of the Migration Act 1958
 which allows for cancellation when the circumstances for the granting of a
 Protection visa no longer exist.
