Senator Cash asked:

Destruction of documents: How many refugees have been resettled in Australia from Indonesia and Malaysia in the last financial year? Please provide a breakdown.

Answer.

During the 2010-11 program year a total of 990 refugees were granted a humanitarian visa and resettled in Australia from Indonesia and Malaysia. Table 1 provides a breakdown of the number of persons granted a humanitarian visa by Post of grant and by visa category for the 2010-11 program year.
