Senator Cash asked:

I refer to the Commonwealth Ombudsman report entitled "Detention arrangements – the transfer of 22 detainees from Villawood Immigration Detention Centre to the Metropolitan Remand and Reception Centre Silverwater" dated April 2012 and I ask: PAM3 states that a person in immigration detention MUST be provided with a Notice of transfer to a correctional facility, and that copies MUST be sent to the legal representatives or migration agent of the person in detention, so why did this not happen?

Answer.

Copies of written notices of the transfers were provided to the clients and their representatives/migration agents. The timing of these processes is detailed in the response to Question BE12/0383.
