(BE13/0038) PROGRAM – 1.1: Visa and Migration

Senator Cash (L&CA 67) asked:

Senator CASH: What is the charge for a secondary applicant?

Mr Bowles: We will take that on notice.

Answer:

As at 27 May 2013, there is no separate application charge for secondary applicants of the Significant Investor Visa. However, if a secondary applicant aged 18 years and above does not have functional English, they are required to pay \$4250 before the visa is granted.
