Senator Cash (L&CA 83) asked:

Senator CASH: Because nothing has been processed, apart from the preliminary assessment. So there are 5,000 currently who have not received a place. You were going to get me the comparative figures for 2011-12. We have established 12,000 refugees, 500 SH visas and 7,000 onshore, which gets us to our 20,000. In relation to last year, 13,750, what is the breakdown? Mr Bowles: It is 6,000 refugees to start with, I think it was 500 SHP—Senator CASH: So half the number of refugees, the same number of special humanitarian—

Mr Bowles: I think so. We will get you the exact figures. We went from 6,000 to 12,000 on the refugee front.
