- Did you study in your home country?
- Please provide the details of your immediate family members (such as parents, grandparents and/or siblings) in your home country

- What is your current occupation (the occupation you had prior to leaving your home country)?
- Where did you reside just prior to leaving for Australia? Was this a different location to where you were born?
- What are your reasons for coming to Australia?
- Do you have any other reasons for coming to Australia?
- Would you like to add anything else?

Interviewing officers may ask further questions if required.
