IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP PORTFOLIO

(BE13/0365) PROGRAM – 4.2: Onshore Detention Network

Senator Cash (Written) asked:

What is the current operational and contingency capacity at Inverbrackie?
Has capacity been exceeded in 2012-13? If so, when and for how long?

Answer:

As at 28 May 2013:

- The published operational capacity at Inverbrackie APOD was 380.
- The published contingency capacity at Inverbrackie APOD was 400.

Client numbers are continuously monitored and adjusted across the immigration detention network to ensure accommodation needs are met. If a centre exceeds published operational capacity it moves into contingency capacity. Specific details on the duration a centre may have exceeded operational capacity are not available as it would require an unreasonable diversion of resources to extract the information.
