Senator Cash (Written) asked:

What is the current operational and contingency capacity at Darwin? Has capacity been exceeded in 2012-13? If so, when and for how long?

Answer:

As at 28 May 2013 the published operational and contingency capacity for each facility in Darwin is as follows:

Immigration detention facility	Operational capacity	Contingency capacity
Berrimah House APOD	16	16
Darwin Airport Lodge APOD	585	762
Northern IDC	456	554
Wickham Point IDC	1410	1410
Wickham Point APOD	500	500
Total	2967	3242

Client numbers are continuously monitored and adjusted across the immigration detention network to ensure accommodation needs are met. If a centre exceeds published operational capacity it moves into contingency capacity. Specific details on the duration a centre may have exceeded operational capacity are not available as it would require an unreasonable diversion of resources to extract the information.
