How much funding was received from the South-Australian Attorney-General's Office?

The South-Australian Attorney-General's Department agreed to pay the AIC an initial \$450,000 (excl GST) over a three year period commencing January 2002. A further payment was subsequently received for \$75,000 (excl GST) to extend the monitoring program into 2004-05.
