**Question No. 118**

**Senator Brown asked the following question on 31 October 2005:**

- (a) Is it the usual practice that someone deported or removed from Australia is accompanied by immigration official?
  - (i) Why was it deemed necessary in Scott Parkin's case?
  - (ii) Is the Minister informed?
  - (iii) Was the Minister informed in Scott Parkin's case?
- (b) Is it usual practice for someone to be charged for the cost of officials accompanying them when they are deported?
- (c) Where did the immigration officers stay while in Los Angeles?
- (d) Did they stay in Disneyland?

**The answer to the honourable senator's questions is as follows:**
