Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 31 October 2006:

With reference to page 116 of the Annual Report and regarding the firearms import permits mentioned at page 116:

- (a) Are the weapons stamped with serial numbers at or before time of entry?
- (b) Is this documentation kept?
- (c) Does this include ammunition?
- (d) Please provide a breakdown of firearms by type.
- (e) Please provide a breakdown of firearms imports by purpose or intended use (eg military purchase, retail, law enforcement etc.)

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

(a) Yes.

Schedule 6 Part 2 of the *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956* requires that in order for import permission to be granted for any firearm manufactured after 1900 that firearm must bear a unique serial number.

- (b) Yes.
- (c) No there is no requirement for ammunition to be marked with a serial number in order to be imported.
