**Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 31 October 2006:**

With reference to page 120 of the Annual Report and Minister Ruddock/Coonan/ Nairn Media Release Review of the E-Security National Agenda regarding the E-Security National Review to which submissions closed on 8 May 2006:

- (a) Given its unavailability at the DCITA site as at 26 October 2006, has a report been finalised, and if so, can it please be provided.
- (b) If the report has not been finalised, (i) can you please specify the completion date; (ii) will the report be released to the public; and (iii) if not, can a summary of its findings be provided.

**The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:**

- (a) The report of the Review of the E-Security National Agenda is in the final stages of completion. The report is classified and the document will not be publicly available.
- (b)(i) The report is in the final stages of completion. It is expected that it will be finalised in early 2007.
  - (ii) The report is classified and the document will not be made available publicly.
  - (iii) The Government will consider how the findings are communicated publicly once the report has been received and considered.
