Living in Harmony Programme

The Living in Harmony community grants programme commenced in 1999. Since then, there have been a total of 304 grants awarded to a variety of organisations to fund local community projects. Information on these projects and the funded organisations is listed by year and by state and territory on the Living in Harmony website (www.harmony.gov.au).

The Living in Harmony partnerships programme enables the Australian Government to work in partnership with major organisations and peak bodies on projects of national and strategic significance. Since 1998, \$2 million has been provided to fund more than 35 collaborative partnerships. Information on a selection of these partnerships can be found on the Living in Harmony website (www.harmony.gov.au).

Multicultural Affairs Programme

In 2005-06, grants under the multicultural affairs programme were made to three multicultural related organisations (the funding for FACC and the Eritrean Community was made on the basis of specific needs). Breakdown of grants is as follows.
