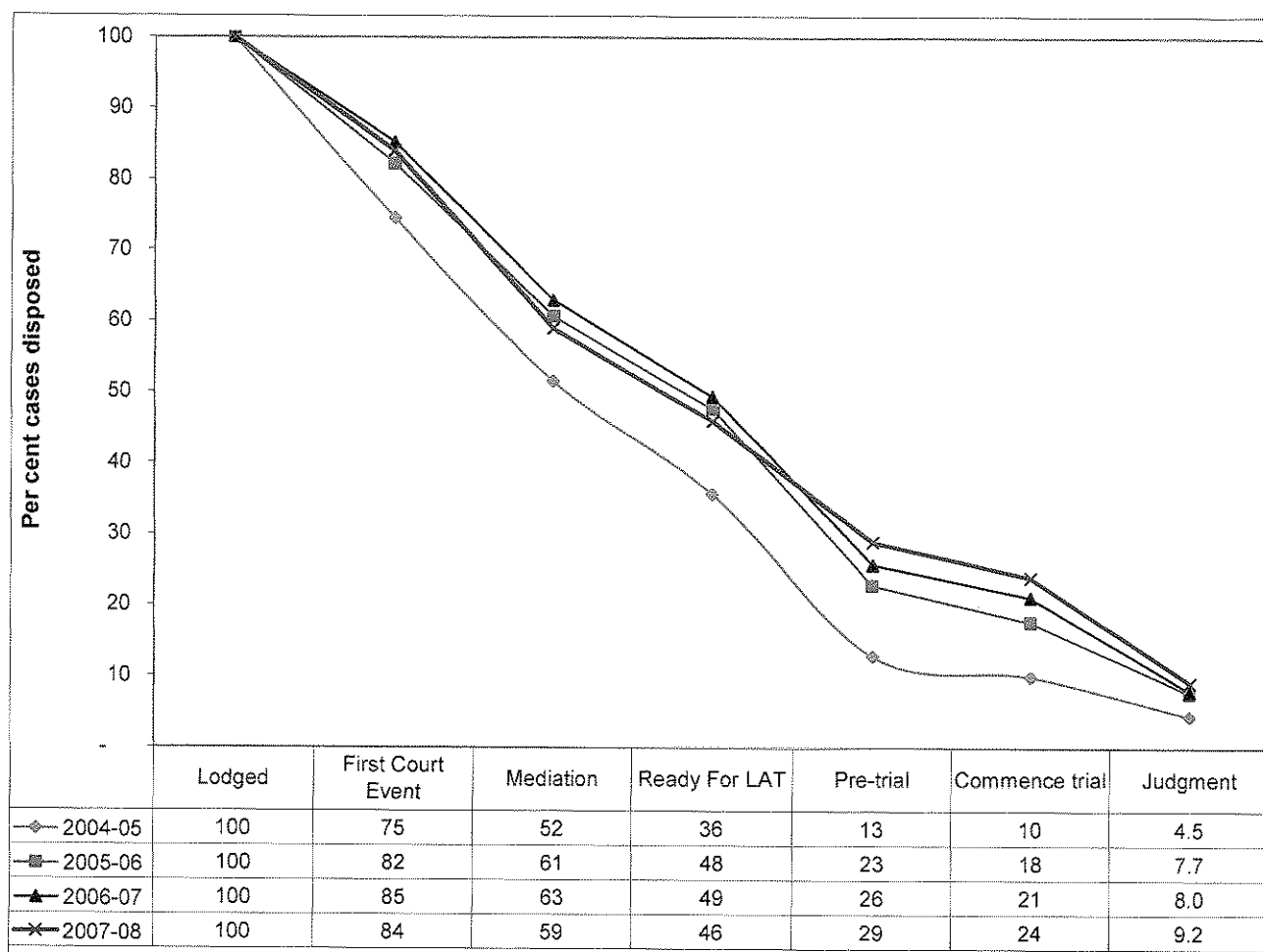


Attrition Rates & Case Clearance in the FCoA



This graph illustrates:

- the number of applications for final orders has reduced since 2004/05 however the percentage of cases proceeding to trial and disposal rates of cases is greater than previous years.
- that the Family Court is disposing of a greater percentage of cases than previous years with fewer 1st instance judges.
- a greater percentage of cases are proceeding to trial than previous years.

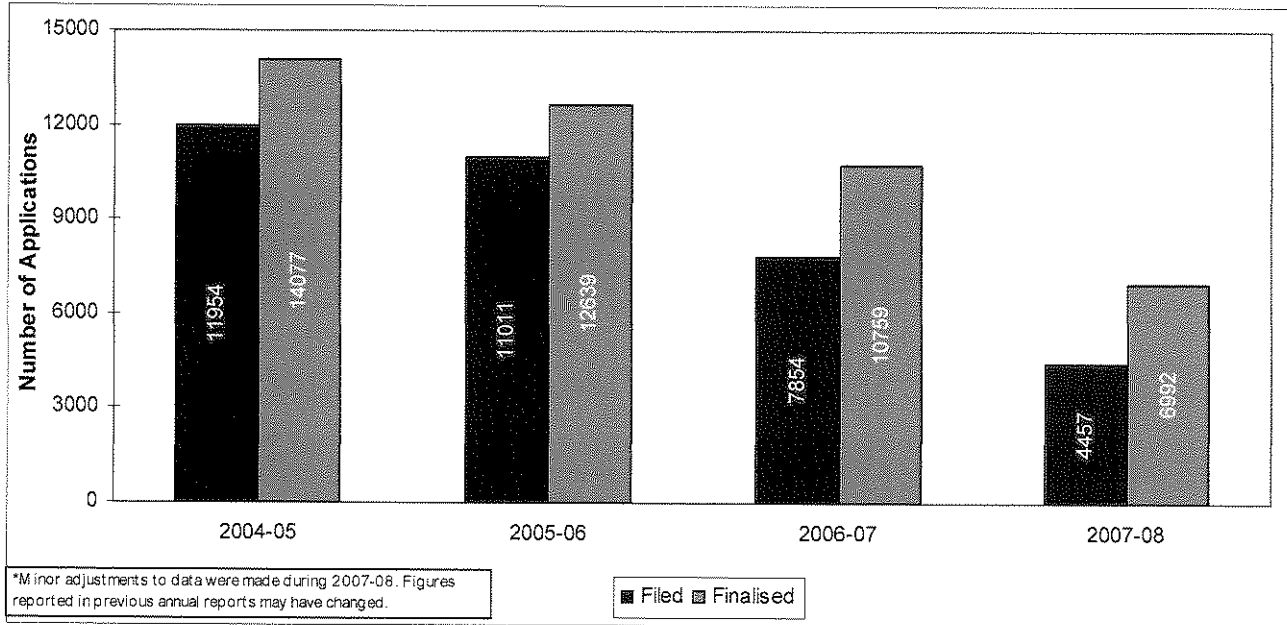

- The graph above shows that the Court has consistently finalised more cases than those filed therefore reducing the size of its backlog of active cases.
