**Question No. 94**

**Senator Barnett asked the following question following the hearing on 19 October 2009:**

It was reported in The Canberra Times 14/08/09 that ASIO Director General of Security, David Irvine AO was caught with his private details publicly available on the electoral roll. Has this matter been rectified? Please provide details of how this occurred and why.

**The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:**

All Australian citizens are required to be recorded on the electoral roll including the Director-General of Security, Mr David Irvine AO. It is up to the individual as to whether the details recorded on the electoral roll are made private.
