Senator Barnett asked the following question at the hearing on 19 October 2009:

In relation to the High Court being open to the public and performing a duty of providing public education and appreciation of the rule of law in Australia;

- a) is the High Court receiving adequate funding to perform this function effectively,
- b) has there been a reduction of hours the Court is open to the public over the past 12 months? Please provide details, and
- c) are there any plans to reduce public opening hours in the foreseeable future?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:
