Senator Cash asked:

- 1) How many onshore protection visa applications, by nationality, were lodged by people who were not IMAs who arrived with visas and were lawful at the time of application?
- 2) How many of these were later found to have fraudulent documentation?

Answer.

Historical point-in-time information about the lawfulness of Protection visa applicants at the time of application is not readily available in consolidated form and it would be a major task to assemble it. The practice of successive governments has been not to authorise the expenditure of time and money involved in such assembly.
