# (283) Program 4.2: Onshore Detention Network

### Senator Cash asked:

- (1) What is the standard for the design and fit-out of Immigration Facilities for single occupancy.
- (2) Is this standard being met at the Curtin immigration detention facility and at the Leonora site?

### Answer.

- (1) The <u>Standards for the Design and Fitout of Immigration Facilities</u> provide for 10m<sup>2</sup> for single occupancy, with a maximum of two people per bedroom in times of surge or contingency capacity (5 m<sup>2 per</sup> person).
- (2) Due to the increase in Irregular Maritime Arrivals, the standards on square metres per person are not being met at Curtin. Leonora is a facility for families and in this context acceptable community solutions apply.
