Senator Barnett asked:

What has been the general staffing trend in your department and portfolio agencies since the 2007 election (for example SES numbers and recruitment has increased by X per cent because of Y).

Answer.

As at 30 November 2007 the Department's headcount was 6737 which increased to 7106 as at 30 June 2008 due to the commencement of a large number of non-ongoing staff. Since 30 June 2008 the Department decreased by 1.5% to a headcount of 6998 as at 30 June 2010. This decrease was driven by a reduction in external recruitment and natural attrition.

Since 30 June 2010 the Department's headcount has grown by 3.8% to 7267, which is due to increased external recruitment to meet the departmental requirements for irregular maritime arrivals and increased recruitment (particularly of non-ongoing staff) in the department's service centres.

The Migration Review Tribunal and Refugee Review Tribunal staffing trends have remained relatively stable over the period.
