## Senator Cash asked:

Processing times – in all 457 visa processing locations: What is the average processing time for onshore and offshore applications for General Skilled Migration for the last five financial years?

## Answer:

It should be noted that General Skilled Migration (GSM) is a separate program to subclass 457 Temporary Business.

Processing for GSM applications is now consolidated in Adelaide and Brisbane. The caseload composition is different in each location with Brisbane processing only applications lodged online in Australia and Adelaide processing onshore paper applications and all offshore lodgements.
